## Dr Miranda LOU Executive Vice President The Hong Kong Polytechnic University

Dr Miranda Lou is Executive Vice President of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, responsible for planning and management of the University's resources and affairs. The scope of her responsibility covers finance; human resources; information technology; campus development and facilities management; knowledge transfer and entrepreneurship; mainland, alumni, communications and public affairs; subsidiaries management; and legal and governance.

Dr Lou had worked for Wharf (Holdings) Limited, Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) and Orient Overseas Container Line Limited (OOCL Group).
