1. TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.1 Based on the Service Agreement (No.: VA1755), the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ), in the capacity of the Accreditation Authority as provided for under the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Ordinance (Cap 592) (AAVQO), was commissioned by UOW College Hong Kong (“Operator”) to conduct a Learning Programme Accreditation (LPA) Exercise with the following Terms of Reference:

- (a) To conduct an accreditation test as provided for in AAVQO to determine whether the Certificate in Modern Logistics Studies (Senior Secondary Applied Learning) programme of the Operator meets the stated objectives and Hong Kong Qualifications Framework (HKQF, or in short QF) Level 3 standards and can be offered as an accredited programme; and
- (b) To issue to the Operator an accreditation report setting out the results of the determination in relation to (a) by HKCAAVQ.

1.2 The accreditation exercise was conducted according to the relevant accreditation guidelines referred to in the Service Agreement. A site visit between the Accreditation Panel and representatives of the Operator took place on 7 June 2024.

2. HKCAAVQ’S DETERMINATION

Learning Programme Accreditation

2.1 HKCAAVQ has determined that the Certificate in Modern Logistics Studies (Senior Secondary Applied Learning) programme meets the stated objectives and QF standard at Level 3, and can be offered as an accredited programme with a validity period from 1 September 2024 to 31 August 2029.

<u>Recommendation 1</u> The Operator should adjust the content of Module 3 and Module 4 to better facilitate senior secondary school students in attaining the QF Level 3 standard.
<u>Recommendation 2</u> The Operator should ensure that the learning and teaching activities involving the adoption of various simulation and logistics scenarios in technology software and tools are ready for use before the commencement of the programme. The Operator should also ensure that students have access to programme-related software for participating in learning and teaching, regardless of the mode of programme delivery they choose.

2.5 HKCAAVQ will subsequently satisfy itself whether the Operator remains competent to achieve the relevant objectives and the Programme continues to meet the standard to achieve the relevant objectives as claimed by the Operator by reference to, amongst other things, the Operator's fulfilment of any conditions and compliance with any restrictions stipulated in this Accreditation Report. For the avoidance of doubt, maintenance of accreditation status is subject to fulfilment of any condition and compliance with any restriction stipulated in this Accreditation Report.

3. INTRODUCTION

3.1 UOW College Hong Kong (UOWCHK), formerly the Community College of City University of Hong Kong (CCCU), is an educational institution wholly-owned by the University of Wollongong (UOW), Australia. UOWCHK has been registered in Hong Kong as an approved post-secondary college with degree-granting status under the

Post Secondary Colleges Ordinance (Cap. 320), offering a range of academic programmes from Diploma to Bachelor's levels. Besides, UOWCHK and UOW have been jointly offering non-local top-up degree programmes in Hong Kong leading to UOW awards.

- 3.2 The programme has been approved by the quality assurance mechanism of Education Bureau (EDB) as an Applied Learning Course. A differentiation approach has been adopted in the Learning Programme Accreditation Exercise, the accreditation processes are customised, the amount of evidence collection is reduced. The Operator is not required to submit documents under Domain of Competence: LPA-2 "Learner Admission and Selection" and LPA-6 "Learning, Teaching and Enabling Resources/Services".

4. PROGRAMME DETAILS

The following is the programme information provided by the Operator.

4.1 Programme Objectives

The objective of this programme is to help students gain an understanding of cross-border e-commerce logistics principles and the management of logistics operations in international online retail business scenario. Students will demonstrate their understanding of the key elements that contribute to successful cross-border e-commerce logistics. Moreover, students will apply problem-solving skills to logistics operations, explore technology tools and software relevant to modern logistics, and collaborate in teams to plan and execute logistics operations.

4.2 Programme Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the programme, learners should be able to:

- PILO-1. describe the concepts, principles, and practices of modern logistics;
- PILO-2. apply problem solving skills to the efficient handling and transportation in modern logistics;
- PILO-3. explore and utilize technology tools and software relevant to modern logistics, such as inventory management systems, tracking and tracing technologies, and data analytics;
- PILO-4. explain the environmental and social impacts of modern logistics practices and identify sustainable and responsible logistics practices;
- PILO-5. communicate effectively and professionally with stakeholders involved in modern logistics, including suppliers, manufacturers, distributors, and customers;
- PILO-6. apply collaborative skills with team members to plan, coordinate and execute modern logistics operations;

PILO-7. describe the work ethics and demonstrate positive values and attitudes at work; and

PILO-8. develop their career aspirations and orientation for lifelong learning.

4.4 Graduation Requirements

- Obtained an overall grade D (i.e. 50-59 marks) of all assessment tasks (note: the cut score for “Attained” is to be moderated by the HKEAA); and
- Attained a minimum attendance rate of 80% of the total number of contact hours.

4.5 Admission Requirements

This is a Senior Secondary Applied Learning Course. Applicants have to meet the admission requirements set by the Education Bureau.

5. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THIS ACCREDITATION REPORT

5.1 Variation and withdrawal of this Accreditation Report

5.1.1 This Accreditation Report is issued pursuant to section 5 of the AAVQO, and contains HKCAAVQ's substantive determination regarding the accreditation, including the validity period as well as any conditions and restrictions subject to which the determination is to have effect.

5.1.2 HKCAAVQ may subsequently decide to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report if it is satisfied that any of the grounds set out in section 5 (2) of the AAVQO apply.

- 5.1.3 If HKCAAVQ decides to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report, it will give the Operator notice of such variation or withdrawal pursuant to section 5(4) of the AAVQO.
- 5.1.4 The accreditation status of the Operator and/or Programme will lapse immediately upon the expiry of the validity period or upon the issuance of a notice of withdrawal of this Accreditation Report.

5.2 Appeals

- 5.2.1 If the Operator is aggrieved by the determination made in this Accreditation Report, then pursuant to Part 3 of the AAVQO the Operator has a right of appeal to the Appeal Board. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 days of the receipt of this Accreditation Report.
- 5.2.2 If the Operator is aggrieved by a decision to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report, then pursuant to Part 3 of the AAVQO the Operator has a right of appeal to the Appeal Board. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 days of the receipt of the Notice of Variation or Withdrawal.
- 5.2.3 The Operator should be aware that a notice of variation or withdrawal of this Accreditation Report is not itself an accreditation report and the right to appeal against HKCAAVQ's substantive determination regarding accreditation arises only from this Accreditation Report.

5.3 **Qualifications Register**

- 5.3.1 Qualifications accredited by HKCAAVQ are eligible for entry into the QR at www.hkqr.gov.hk for recognition under the QF. The Operator should apply separately to have their quality-assured qualifications entered into the QR.
- 5.3.2 Only learners who commence the study of the named accredited learning programme during the validity period and who have graduated with the named qualification listed in the QR will be considered to have acquired a qualification recognised under the QF.
