1. TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.1 Based on the Service Agreement (No.: VA1837), the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ), in the capacity of the Accreditation Authority as provided for under the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Ordinance (Cap. 592) (AAVQO), was commissioned by Caritas Bianchi College of Careers (Operator) to conduct a Learning Programme Re-accreditation (re-LPA) Exercise with the following Terms of Reference:

- (a) To conduct an accreditation test as provided for in AAVQO to determine whether the following programmes of the Operator meet the stated objectives and Hong Kong Qualifications Framework (QF) Levels 3-4 standards, and can continue to be offered as accredited programmes:
 - (i) Professional Diploma in Property Management;
 - (ii) Higher Diploma in Human Services;
 - (iii) Higher Diploma in Translation Technology and Modern Languages; and
 - (iv) Diploma in Health Sciences
- (b) To issue to the Operator an accreditation report setting out the results of the determinations in relation to (a) by HKCAAVQ.

1.2 The accreditation exercise was conducted according to the relevant accreditation guidelines referred to in the Service Agreement. The Education Bureau's "*Updated Revised Common Descriptors for Associate Degree and Higher Diploma Programmes (Effective since the 2024/25 academic year)*" (AD/HD Common Descriptors) was also a guiding document used by the Panel and the Operator in conducting this exercise for the Higher Diploma (HD) programmes. A site visit took place on 18-19 February 2025.

3. INTRODUCTION

- 3.1 Established in 1971 and formerly known as the Bishop Bianchi College of Careers, Caritas Bianchi College of Careers (CBCC) is a self-financed Catholic education institute operated under the Community & Higher Education Service of Caritas - Hong Kong. At present, CBCC is offering nine sub-degree programmes, one professional diploma programme and two diploma programmes.
- 3.2 In consideration of CBCC's positive track record from previous accreditation exercises, re-LPA of the following programmes was conducted in the form of paper-based review in accordance with HKCAAVQ's Differentiation Approach to accreditation:
- Professional Diploma in Property Management
 - Higher Diploma in Human Services

4. PROGRAMME DETAILS

The following is the programme information provided by the Operator.

4.1 Programme Objectives

Professional Diploma in Property Management

Higher Diploma in Human Services

The programme aims to provide students with a broad and enriched learning experience in human services and to enhance their intellectual and personal development. The programme also includes General Education (GE) and different required courses in its curriculum. Such a basic and rich scope will enable students to make their best informed-decisions in deciding their goals for further studies and career development.

Higher Diploma in Translation Technology and Modern Languages

The programme aims to train students to achieve the following objectives upon graduation:

- PO1 Operate with an effective command of written and spoken English and Chinese for effective translation purposes;
- PO2 Operate with a basic understanding of an additional foreign language for general communication purposes;
- PO3 Demonstrate acquaintance with and operational skills in translation technology; and
- PO4 Operate with a broad general knowledge, generic skills and an awareness of cultural elements that underpin translation and related administrative tasks.

Diploma in Health Sciences

The programme aims to:

1. build up students' foundational knowledge in the health sciences discipline to pave the way for their development as healthcare personnel;
2. equip students with the fundamental skills used in the healthcare sector; and
3. develop students' language and communication skills for their future vocational and/or academic endeavours.

5. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THIS ACCREDITATION REPORT

5.1 Variation and withdrawal of this Accreditation Report

- 5.1.1 This Accreditation Report is issued pursuant to section 5 of the AAVQO, and contains HKCAAVQ's substantive determination regarding the accreditation, including the validity period as well as any conditions and restrictions subject to which the determination is to have effect.
- 5.1.2 HKCAAVQ may subsequently decide to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report if it is satisfied that any of the grounds set out in section 5 (2) of the AAVQO apply. This includes where HKCAAVQ is satisfied that the Operator is no longer competent to achieve the relevant objectives and/or the Programme no longer meets the standard to achieve the relevant objectives as claimed by the Operator (whether by reference to the Operator's failure to fulfil any conditions and/or comply with any restrictions stipulated in this Accreditation Report or otherwise) or where at any time during the validity period there has/have been substantial change(s) introduced by the Operator after HKCAAVQ has issued the accreditation report(s) to the Operator and which has/have not been approved by HKCAAVQ. Please refer to the '*Guidance Notes on Substantial Change to Accreditation Status*' in seeking approval for proposed changes. These Guidance Notes can be downloaded from the HKCAAVQ website.
- 5.1.3 If HKCAAVQ decides to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report, it will give the Operator notice of such variation or withdrawal pursuant to section 5(4) of the AAVQO.
- 5.1.4 The accreditation status of the Operator and/or Programme will lapse immediately upon the expiry of the validity period or upon the issuance of a notice of withdrawal of this Accreditation Report.

5.2 Appeals

- 5.2.1 If the Operator is aggrieved by the determination made in this Accreditation Report, then pursuant to Part 3 of the AAVQO the Operator has a right of appeal to the Appeal Board. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 days of the receipt of this Accreditation Report.
- 5.2.2 If the Operator is aggrieved by a decision to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report, then pursuant to Part 3 of the AAVQO the Operator has a right of appeal to the Appeal Board. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 days of the receipt of the Notice of Variation or Withdrawal.
- 5.2.3 The Operator should be aware that a notice of variation or withdrawal of this Accreditation Report is not itself an accreditation report and the right to appeal against HKCAAVQ's substantive determination regarding accreditation arises only from this Accreditation Report.
- 5.2.4 Please refer to Cap 592A (www.elegislation.gov.hk) for the appeal rules. Details of the appeal procedure are contained in section 13 of the AAVQO and can be accessed from the QF website at: www.hkqf.gov.hk.

5.3 **Qualifications Register**

- 5.3.1 Qualifications accredited by HKCAAVQ are eligible for entry into the QR at www.hkqr.gov.hk for recognition under the QF. The Operator should apply separately to have their quality-assured qualifications entered into the QR.
- 5.3.2 Only learners who commence the study of the named accredited learning programme during the validity period and who have graduated with the named qualification listed in the QR will be considered to have acquired a qualification recognised under the QF.
